### First Contact Place (FCP)

The First Contact Place (FCP) in Ashaiman primarily serves as a day care Centre for new beneficiaries from the streets, to prepare them for school life. Prep activities also take place for beneficiaries who are reintegrated into their families and are attending school in Ashaiman and its environs.





#### WEM Centre

The Welfare - Empowerment - Mobility - Centre is located in Ayikuma where our beneficiaries get temporal accommodation. They attend basic school in Ayikuma. After school the beneficiaries are engaged in daily preps to do their homework and get some extra academic training.





#### WEM Farm

The WEM farm is our maiden local income generation module. We currently have a mango plantation, poultry and grass cutter rearing on the farm.
