- Appointed a 6-team committee to head the local fundraising process.



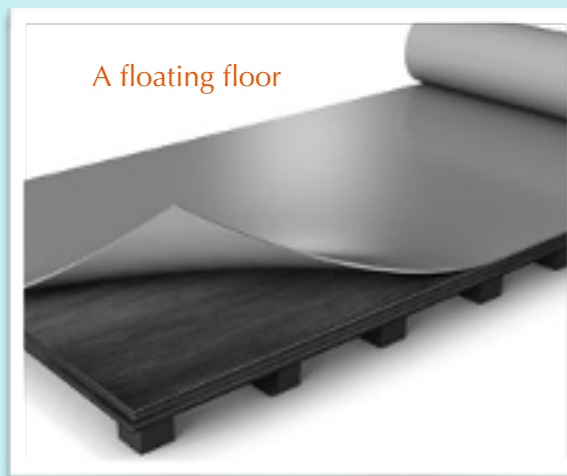
- Agreed on pro-forma fundraising, and each family took an initiative to raise money through friends and wider community.

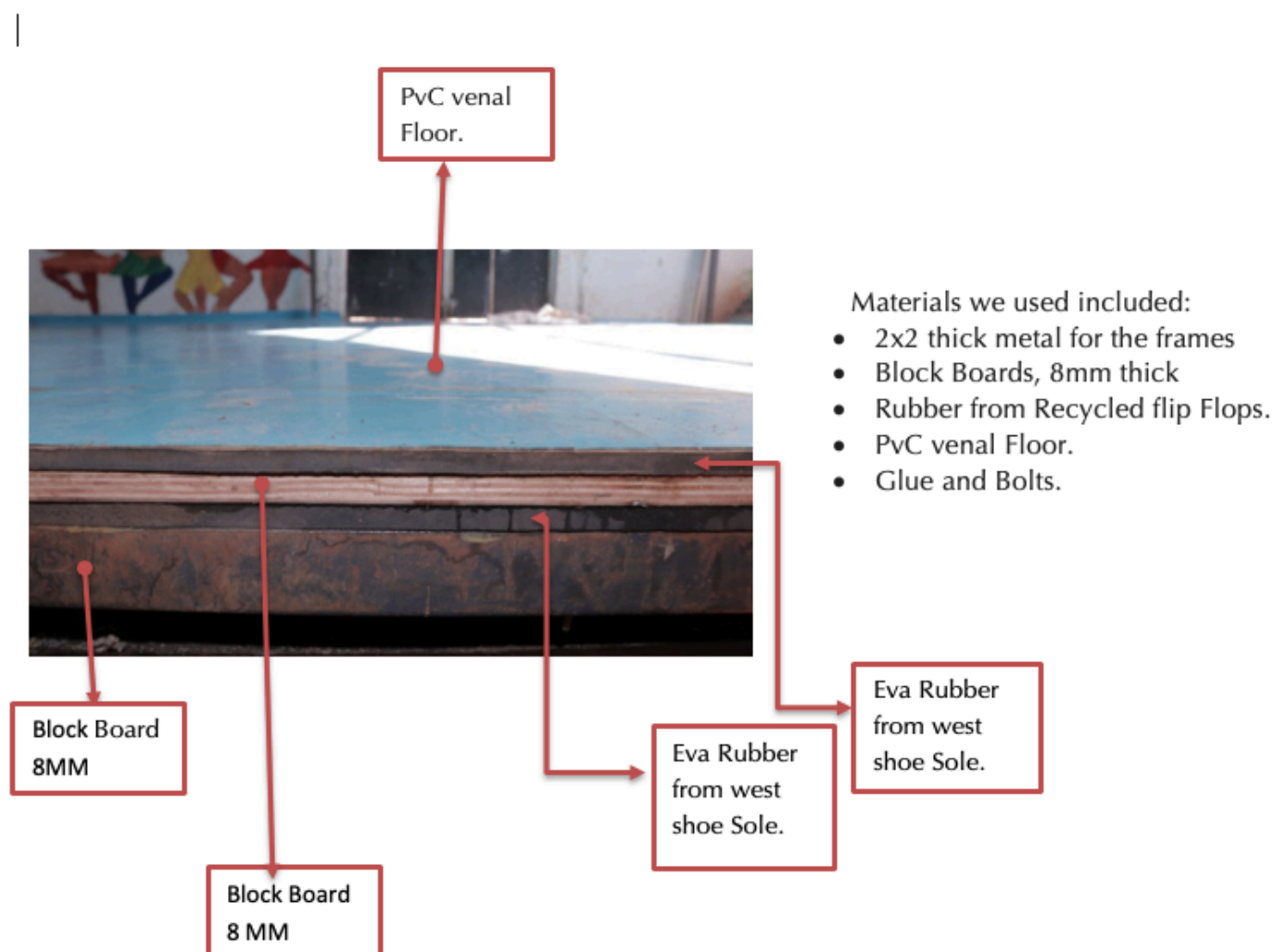
After lots of consultation with our global dance school partners and acknowledging access to materials, skills and a disrupted global trade system, we came up with a design that would use readily available materials to realize the project.

## The New Floor

Built from readily available materials, the new floor at project Elimu matches all required safety standards.





## The Process



1. Digging  $\frac{1}{2}$  a meter-deep hole and sinking Metal  $\frac{3}{4}$  as the base to hold the space.

2. Leveling and installation of platform

3. Blockboard laying

4. Rubber and PVC installation

5. New Look project Elimu Dance Floor

We have also managed to install a water tank for water storage, connected CCTV cameras, installed video conference cameras and a conference Tv.



We Have installed a conference call camera and a smart tv. We will now be able to teach follow Dance classes from our Partner Dance schools around the Globe.



We have managed to connect the space with running water installed a 5000 water tank and hand wash taps. This is a huge boost to our program as we can now fully emphasize on the importance of hand wash to the Children.





## CCTv and biometric Instalation

We ware able to instal an eight camera CCTv to enable us be on the look out for the children while they are at the space. We are curently working on the configuration on our biometric register and once ready it will help us in tracking the atendance and also send text messages direct to parents when thechildren arive and leave the space.
