



Gura Humorului Library Project

In partnership with Te Aud Romania, WeTomorrow will transform this mundane meeting room into an inspiring library with Romanian and English books, there will be new furniture, laptops and a projector – and one of the most exciting features will be a castle with steps and pillows (at one end of the room) for cozy reading.

During the week of refurbishment, the volunteers will also conduct a summer camp for around 60 underprivileged children from Gura Humorului.

Every morning we will start with English education for the 15-20 children from the local orphanage. After this lesson, 45 more children will join us for various activities such as arts & crafts, sports, music or other creative pursuits with a break for lunch.

One day will be dedicated to the environment and the volunteers and the children will pick up litter around town.

On the last day we will have an "Olympic Games" event at the local park.

Once back the volunteers have returned from the project, they will continue giving English lessons to the children from the orphanage, once a week. This is an incredible way of keeping in touch and creating a much bigger impact than just the physical installation of a library.
