Recovering Oklahomans After Disaster, Inc. staff has served through six disasters in the past five years helping hundreds of disaster survivors who have no means of recovery on their own. We have served along side thousands of volunteers directing their work to make these homes home again.

Our staff has experience assessing the home damages, making materials lists, receiving cost estimates, delivering materials to the work site, and overseeing the work of the volunteers. We also have experience securing overnight lodging for teams, working with every church denomination, businesses, and university groups. We have a passion to serve and the experience to make the work the most efficient and effective as possible.

We work in a collaborative called the Oklahoma Voluntary Organizations Active in Disaster where each member organization provides a needed set of services. Our role in this collaborative is filling the need for project and volunteer management statewide. Without volunteers and on-site project managers the recovery efforts cannot be completed. It takes everyone doing their part to reach recovery.

These funds are a necessary part of providing experienced, consistent, and constant management for each disaster survivors home that needs repaired when no other means for that family exist. The extent of the 2019 spring storms is not yet fully known, however the numbers that have been tallied show that this recovery effort will take a minimum of 24 months. We are the ROAD to recovery.
