## UGANDA

- Known as the "Pearl of Africa"
- Population: 28.8 million
- Life Expectancy: 53 years
- Median Age: 15 years
- Infant Mortality Rate: 79/1,000
- Literacy Rate: 67%
- Access to Safe Water: 60%
- AIDS has left approx. 44,000 children orphaned
- Since 1971, between 800,000-2 million people perished during the dictatorship of Idi Amin and the civil wars, tribal killings and famines that followed.
- During last 2 decades, the rebel Lord's Resistance Army (LRA) has forced approx. 30,000 children into armed conflict and sex slavery.

## SPONSORING A CHILD

One third of the total annual budget of AHCM is spent as school fees for currently 45 of 47 kids attending schools. Sponsors can make a huge difference by sponsoring just one child for one year. By sponsoring a child, you will receive periodic letters from or about your sponsored child.

## OTHER WAYS TO HELP

### VOLUNTEERING

Volunteers can assist in any variety of ways. AHCM relies on 4 important pillars: the overall well-being of the children, teaching, organized activities, and overseeing important administrative aspects.

### PURCHASING ARTS & CRAFTS

In their spare time, the children at AHCM make a variety of arts & crafts. This includes: bags, various jewelry, hats, postcards, dolls, etc. Great for Christmas or anytime gifts!

### POULTRY & FARMING PROJECTS

These projects are aimed to achieve the following: to promote literacy in Uganda by allowing children to attend school, to provide nutritional food, clothing and medical care funds to the children, to teach the children the life long skills of poultry rearing and farming, and to provide employment.

The total fund needed for both projects is US \$53,400. This will cover the expenses of the first 5-12 months. After which the chickens will start to lay eggs, and the farm will start to generate enough food for the children as well as a surplus that will be sold so the projects can sustain themselves.

### PURCHASING MUSIC & DANCE

Led by Kinene Abubaker (a.k.a. Big Brother) and supported on African drums by Richard Kavuma, almost all children at the orphanage (the youngest being 4!) enjoy singing songs and dancing to the music in traditional wardrobe. The songs have been recorded on DVD and CD.
