Thank you for your support. The patients and health care workers of Kawaye Health Center are now accessing clean drinking water for the first time, and a healthier future is becoming a reality. A new well, drilled by our partner, World Vision, is supplying a much-needed water source to a health care facility that serves the surrounding population of 4,838 people.

Water, sanitation and hygiene committees, comprised of community members, have been trained and have committed to managing the well. Thanks to their focus on community empowerment and sustainability, World Vision's wells established more than 25 years ago remain operational.

We are multiplying the health benefits of clean water by addressing sanitation and hygiene in Kawaye Health Center. Activities include helping people build and maintain sex-separated latrines and promoting handwashing with soap. When combined, water, sanitation, and hygiene interventions can reduce child disease and death, malnutrition rates, and incidence of infection.
