Background

KUN Humanity System + is a self-funded and donor-funded foundation. A collaborative movement composed by doctors, psychologists, cinematographers, engineers, project managers, livelihood specialists, and others; who have extensive experience working with local and international NGO, to provide the most effective and holistic means to respond to emergency situation caused by natural or man-made disasters and to victims of armed conflict.

KUN has started to operate in 2016 by bringing community empowerment to people living in remote area close to Indonesian national parks. It has been registered as a legit Indonesian NGO in 26 March 2018. During its first year of operation, KUN has responded to three emergency situations: Lombok earthquake (July 2018), Palu-Koro fault system earthquake and tsunami (September 2018), and Banten Sunda Strait tsunami (December 2018).

A medical doctor with a passion for the wilderness and disaster relief medicine. He has been involved in many expedition and disaster relief operations as medical support and program coordinator. He also joins international response in many international NGO like Medecines Sans Frontier in Afghanistan and Himalayan Rescue Association in Nepal. He is involved in so many disaster relief operations like volcanic Eruption, earthquake, tsunami, super jet crash incident, flooding, landslide, armed conflicts, etc.





Summary of Work History

July 2016 to June 2018:

KUN had been doing community empowerment to the community living close to Bromo Tengger Semeru National Park, Mount Leuser National Park, Mount Kerinci National Park, and Gede Pangrango National Park. July 2018 to present

KUN has responded to three emergency situations: Lombok earthquake (Ganggelang village in North Lombok district), Palu-Koro fault system earthquake and tsunami (2 villages in 2 districts), and Banten Sunda Strait tsunami (13 villages in Pandeglang and Serang districts).

KUN has used private funding for the initial intervention in emergency response and later has collaborated with other NGOs and international organizations such as International Medical Corps (IMC), Caritas, LIFE, ACTED – ECHO, Christian Aid, etc. During the collaboration with international organizations, KUN has received external funding ranged from US\$ 10,000 to US\$ 150,000.

In total, KUN has reached approximatively 3000 beneficiaries in Lombok, 4700 beneficiaries in Palu-Sigi, and 17000 beneficiaries in Banten. It's all achieved during its first year as an NGO. The program activities done during those emergency situations are emergency response, medical aid, psychosocial support, emergency school construction, logistic distribution, bamboo shelter construction, WASH, DRR, livelihood, and emergency cash grant distribution.
