In the first quarter of 2021, with the masks on their faces and the community on their minds Super-Volunteers started holding their first physical club meetings of the year.



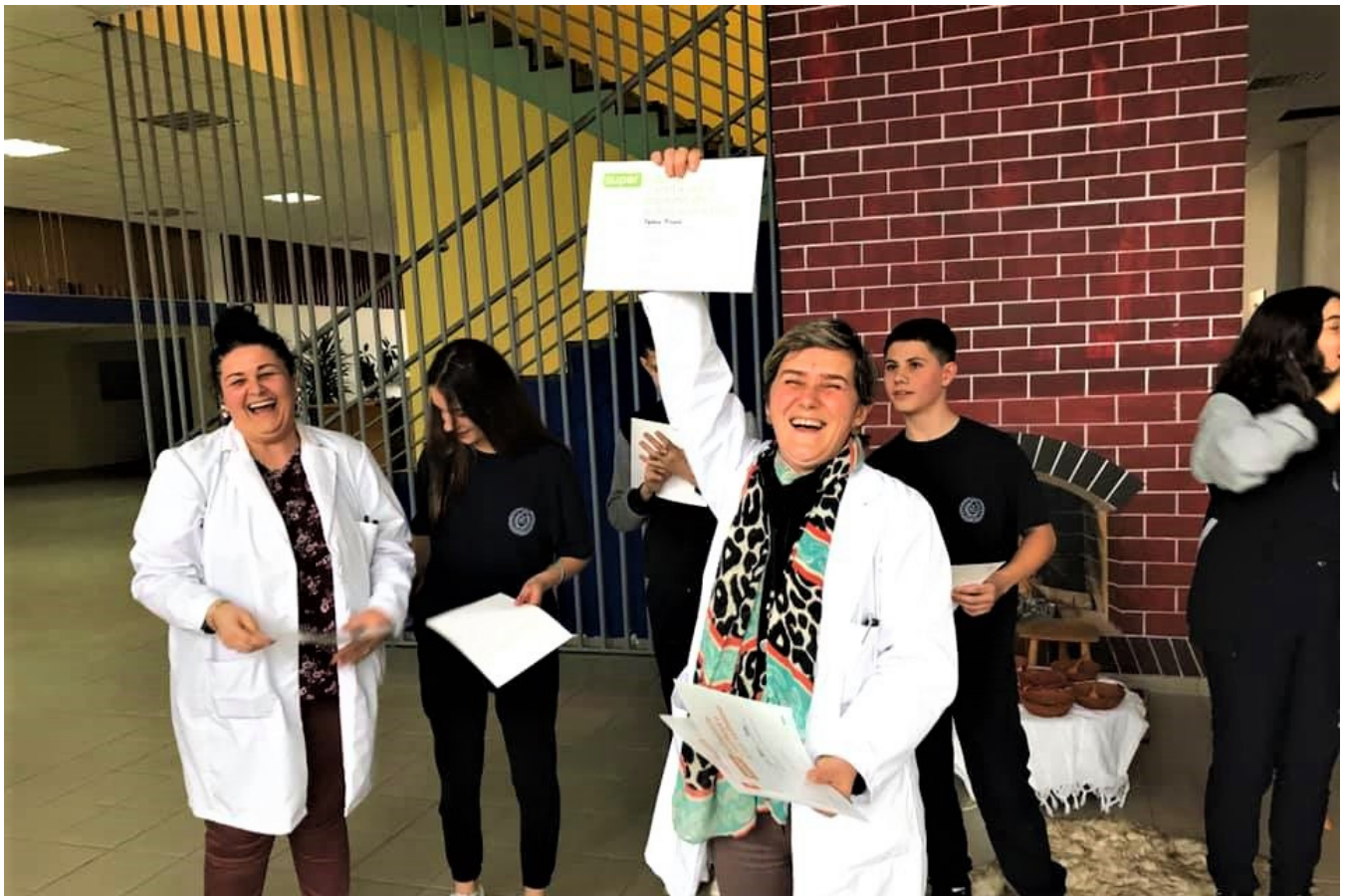
The implementation of the "Empowering Single Moms" project

What's next for Service Learning?

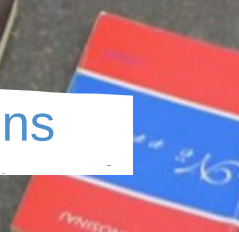
The Service Learning family is always growing. We are currently recruiting new Super-Mentors, and our aim is to have 50 more clubs with 1,000 active volunteers by 2021.
