

Project: Harm reduction due to trafficking in trans women

In the short term, this project seeks to be a platform for the visibility and reception of complaints about trafficking of transgender girls, adolescents and women in Latin America, as well as to offer legal assistance.

At the moment, legal assistance will be only in Mexico, while in the medium term we will be counting the data and generating statistics that help us to make governments understand the need to create public policies that apply from childhood, as many trans girls and adolescents run away from home because of discrimination and violence suffered in their family.

Adult women are attracted to large cities, with the promise of work that they are not able to obtain in their place of origin due to the discrimination and violence that is exercised towards them. They find themselves helpless in the streets, where they are co-opted by organized crime and human traffickers.

In the long term and through the website that we will build, we will create an aid network throughout Latin America, taking as a model the legal assistance work that will be implemented in Mexico.
