



Pan African Christian Exchange (PACE) is a growing ministry based out of Nyahururu, Kenya that we are partnering with. Their aim is to equip the poor with affordable, quality education and health care. One of their main branches is Pan African Academy(PAA), a private Christian school founded in 2003 and is located about 4 hours from Nairobi. PAA provides an integrated academic and social environment from nursery to college with intention to inspire a desire for self rule, self sustainability and personal responsibility. The school also provides spiritual, academic, social and moral needs of marginalized and needy children in society including orphans, street kids and children from minority tribes in Kenya.

There are 2 projects that GUD will partner with them PACE on. The first smaller project is helping to finish the wash stations.

PAA began the construction of two wash stations for their students in the spring of 2018 but were unable to complete them due to financial constraints. Currently, there is only ONE water spigot that services the entire student body comprised of 200 young scholars.

We want to help them complete the wash stations and prevent illnesses and bacterial diseases that are too often contracted by the students.

The wash stations will be used for hand washing, washing laundry and dishes.

Funds raised will be used directly for supplies needed in the construction of the wash stations.

These would include:

- Faucets
- Plumbing
- Masonry work
- Tiling
