We currently have small Womens Centre in rural Buikwe. With practical skills training, business training and which acts as a small community hub. By operating this we have learned the additional value such a facility to bring and are using this as the basis to expand our work with a better center.



Current Plan

We now intend to build a much larger Rural Women's Centre. It will be located centrally between the villages we already work with, so that existing groups can easily access the center. While also enabling the much wider community to access our services. We estimate that we can offer our training services to almost 1,600 vulnerable ladies. To date we have helped 670 to start and run businesses with just an outreach program and tiny, very rural center.

Our new facility will predominantly be a training center offering both business and vocational skills, which will be taught by experienced local women and business mentors.

We have also identified an enormous need for better health care and plan to have a surgery with a fully funded nurse offering free of charge basic health care to all our Women. This is a vitally needed service as health care is both geographically and financially unavailable to most women we work with.

We already have funds to purchase land and are in the process of negotiating for just over an acre, in an ideal location.

We intend to use another local NGO to physically build our new center. This organisation uses a unique compacted earth and cement process which eliminates the need for burning vast amounts of wood to fire bricks. They also operate as a training organisation, offering locals to the build site the opportunity to learn building and associated skills.
