The project will create a space for communication and development of 30 young people with disabilities (cerebral palsy, Down Syndrome, autism, etc.) and their parents from Mykolaiv and Batumi.

## This project will help

30 young people with disabilities:

- to find faith in the future and become more confident, while taking part in arttherapeutic
- groups.
- to develop communicational skills, to build a project of their own future and to be successfully involved in society with the help of developing and educational training courses
- to achieve an ambition and travel to Georgia for participating in Christmas psychological camp for the first time
- to feel care and warmth of strangers after receiving Christmas presents

## **PROJECT BUDGET**

**TOTAL 9800 \$** 

I. 750\$ - Christmas presents for 30 young person with disabilities from Mykolaiv or Batumi will be bought

900 \$- 30 young person with disabilities from Mykolaiv and Batumi will take part in 2 educational and 1 developing training courses

150 \$ - materials for art-therapeutic psychological and support groups will be purchased (stationery, paper, paints, plasticine, etc.)

500 \$ - it will be paid for an organization of coffee breaks during the developing and educational training courses, and support groups

2900 \$- the transfer will be paid for the participation of 12 person from Mykolaiv to Batumi on the Christmas psychological camp

150 - the transfer will be paid for the participation of 12 person to excursions in Georgia

1000 \$ - 30 young people from Mykolaiv and Batumi with disabilities will take part in art-therapeutic psychological groups for 3 months.

3000 \$ - the participation of 10 members from Mykolaiv and 10 members from Batumi with disabilities in the Christmas psychological camp in Georgia (accommodation, excursions, food and training courses) will be paid.

450 \$ - parents of 30 young people with disabilities from Mykolaiv and Batumi will take part in the support group 3 months.
