Early Childhood Education (Children aged 18-36 months)

Early childhood development is key to building fundamental foundations to encourage children to reach their full potential.

The **Little Robin's Playgroup** was initiated in January 2018 at Benoni Child & Youth care centre.

Composed of a daily program consisting of a thematic curriculum, children are instructed through guided play and encouraged to learn through play.

Toddlers are encouraged daily through age appropriate activities to nurture their minds and stimulate their development, ensuring that they reach their developmental milestones.
