Schedule of the Coalition

Kayan's 16 Days of Activism Campaign against Gender-Based Violence of 2019 is focused on the topic of femicide. This issue is critical this year as we, unfortunately, witnessed an increase in the numbers of femicides. This campaign is part of Kayan's long-term, comprehensive, and holistic work on sexual and gender-based violence (SGBV). This campaign is also part of the international 16 Days Campaign, where feminists all over the world hold programming in the weeks between the International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women and International Human Rights Day. We do so to emphasize that women's rights to safety is a human right. Locally, this year's campaign will be especially impactful as Kayan has initiated a coalition of Arab human rights and feminist organizations to promote the message against gender-based violence and coordinate additional programs over the 16 days. Kayan and the coalition will hold more than two- dozen events focused on femicide and SGBV over the course of the campaign.
