## A UNIQUE PROBLEM

Paraguay's education sector is broken.

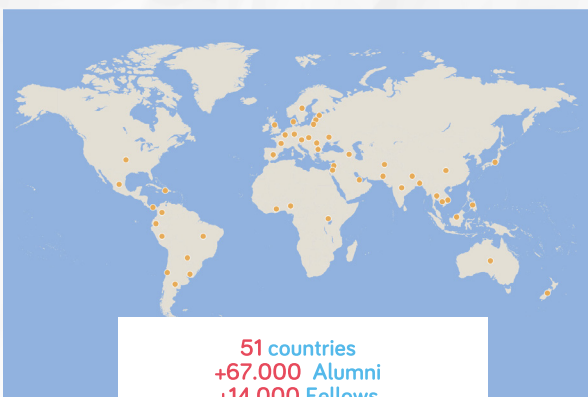
- Almost 50% of teachers did not pass the public teaching contest (Paraguayan Ministry of Education and Science, 2019).
- Paraguay remains one of the 5 least performing countries in terms of quality education, reaching the place 135 of 140 countries between 2017/2019 (World Economic Forum).
- Only 8% of Paraguayan students reach the minimum outcome in mathematics (PISA 2018).

This is a crisis. In order to address Paraguay's most critical problem we must mobilize the country's most capable leaders and transform the barriers that impede that all children achieve their full potential.

## WHO ARE WE?

Enseña por Paraguay is a local NGO that aims to address the educational crisis through enlisting the country's most committed graduates and professionals to ensure that all Paraguayan children can attain an excellent education.

We are part of a growing global network of 51 independent partner organizations with a shared vision of expanding educational opportunity to all children in their respective countries and communities.



## WHAT WE DO?



### Recruitment:

We recruit and select fellows who meet the required skills to generate a positive impact on student outcomes and become leaders who work collectively to achieve systemic changes.



### Train:

We train fellows in leadership and innovative pedagogical methodologies, community work and development in socio-emotional skills. To achieve a common vision of student success and establish the basis for long-term leadership.



### Place:

We place fellows in public schools located in vulnerable communities with whom we work in close partnership, to serve as full-time teachers for two years and work collectively with communities.



### Ongoing Support:

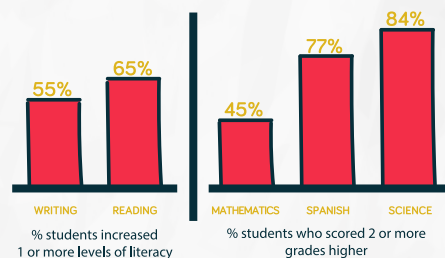
Fellows receive regular professional development, coaching, and mentorship to continually improve their teaching practice and strengthen their leadership skills to influence changes in the systems.

We work also supporting teachers and school principals in the schools that we work with, in order to collectively achieve the vision that we have set for our country.

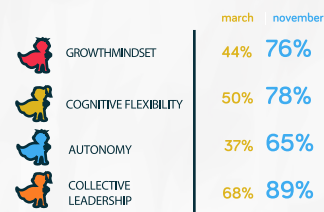

### PERCEPTION OF PRINCIPALS

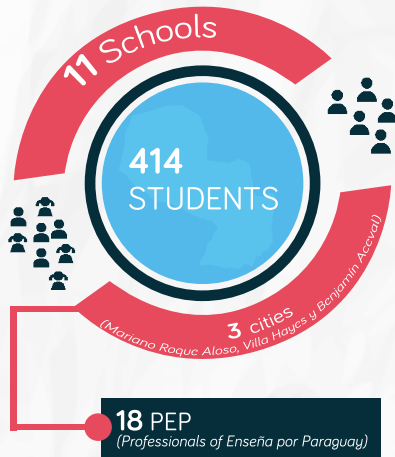

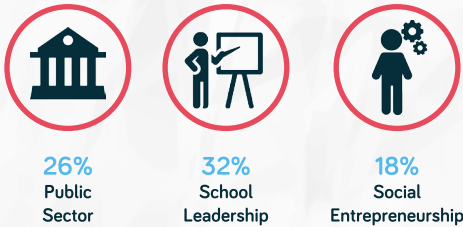


## ALUMNI

*In Latam 76% made the decision to keep on working in the educational sector:*



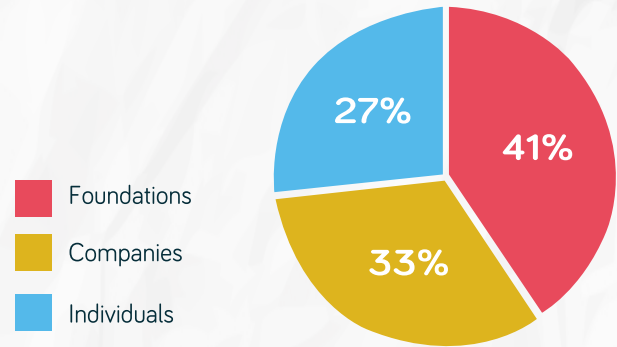
## OUR GROWTH AND SUSTAINABILITY

By 2023 Enseña por Paraguay will serve nearly 2.300 Paraguayan students, greatly improving their life prospects. In order to foster positive learning ecosystems for all students, ExP will also provide mentorship and in-service training for more than 9.200 teachers and principals nationwide who presently receive little to no professional development to improve their teaching practice. Overall in the next 5 years, ExP envision to impact 18.400 individuals, contemplating teachers and principals, students and members of communities. Moreover, 45 alumni will occupy strategic roles in private, public, and academic sector driving ExP's impact across sectors.
