DHARMIK FOUNDATION 2ND Project PANCHAKANYA SCHOOL PAKHURAYE, NUWAKOT, NEPAL

Project Background:

Panchakanaya school is 43Km North-West of Kathmandu. The district is called Nuwakot; and the open border with China is also in the same direction not far from the school location in Rasuwa.

Panchakanya school is located on the edge of beautiful mountain. The school has three concrete floors with five rooms on each floor. There are 175 above students from kindy through to grade 8.

IGWR-Nepal has completed much work for the school over the last 8 years; building another floor of classrooms, five toilets, one shower, two staircases, painting and connecting a drinking water supply to school. IGWR-Nepal also hired four local teachers and a caretaker for three years in order to improve the overall standards within the school.

Project Outline

Dharmik foundation have adopted Panchakanya as their second project after successful completion of a second floor of classrooms they built for another rural school in the Kavre district which has proven to be a great success.

Panchakanya school needs urgent attention in a number of areas, improvements that will also assist in encouraging kids to come school every day. The current school has good infrastructure but needs proper management and some maintenance. Dharmik foundation is willing to help this school to complete the necessary works and will be able to achieve this with the generous support of sponsors and donors. Dharmik foundation provide assurance that all donated monies will be 100% utilized for the work as detailed and there is no administration cost deducted from the monies raised. All financial transactions will be managed via IGWR-Nepal(an Australian Registered Charity) who conduct full audits both in Nepal and independently in Australia.

There will be some budget variations as plans are finalized, paint type, equipment specs etc. and any variations will again be clearly shown on project reports.
