Con Tus Manos - "With Your Hands" provides building material to rebuild homes affected by natural disasters as hurricanes and earthquakes Our programs* A tu Salud, De Mano a Mano, Con Tus Manos and Alacena joined forces to carry out a mega distribution of articles around the entire Island. During the past year, we have impacted more than 575,000 people and we are now ready for the seventh round.

Thanks to our continuous, dedicated, and transparent work, we have been approved to distribute the following items during the <u>next 3 months</u> with the support of the 122 affiliated organizations that joined PRROA**.

- 12 per week-40' container filled with food boxes approximate 200,000 boxes during the length of this project. Each food box provides food for 3 days for a family of 4.
- 10,000 medical / surgery gowns
- 8.000 facial masks
- 10.000 hand sanitizers
- 100,000 gallons of milk
- Wheelchairs and medical equipment
- Building material to 100 families

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- The organizations allied to Puerto Rico Rises (PRROA) are divided into regions.
- Each region has a Regional Coordinator and several Municipal Coordinators that work together on each project to guarantee success, impact reach and minimize duplicity.
- They coordinate through electronic registration the requests of the various organizations by area and require a Mission Report at the conclusion of each of the missions.
- To belong to PRROA, each organization must register, present documentation, sign an MOU, and comply with the required reports and records according to our policy of transparency.

PROJECT METRICS

- Each organization must submit a <u>Mission Report</u> no later than 7 days after each mission.
- Each Regional Coordinator must submit a <u>Regional</u> <u>Report after each project conclusion.</u>
- These reports request among others:
 - o The region, Municipality and Sector impacted
 - Family Unit
 - Demographic Informacion
 - Supplies distributed
 - Volunteers participation
 - Photos and Videos
