The current progress report covers the period 01.09.2022-31.10.2022. Since March 2020 Global Giving has connected the "Bridge of Hope" Armenian NGO to 271 donors and up to date 14,344 USD is raised of \$91,800 goal for the project "Enable 360 children with disabilities in Armenia".
