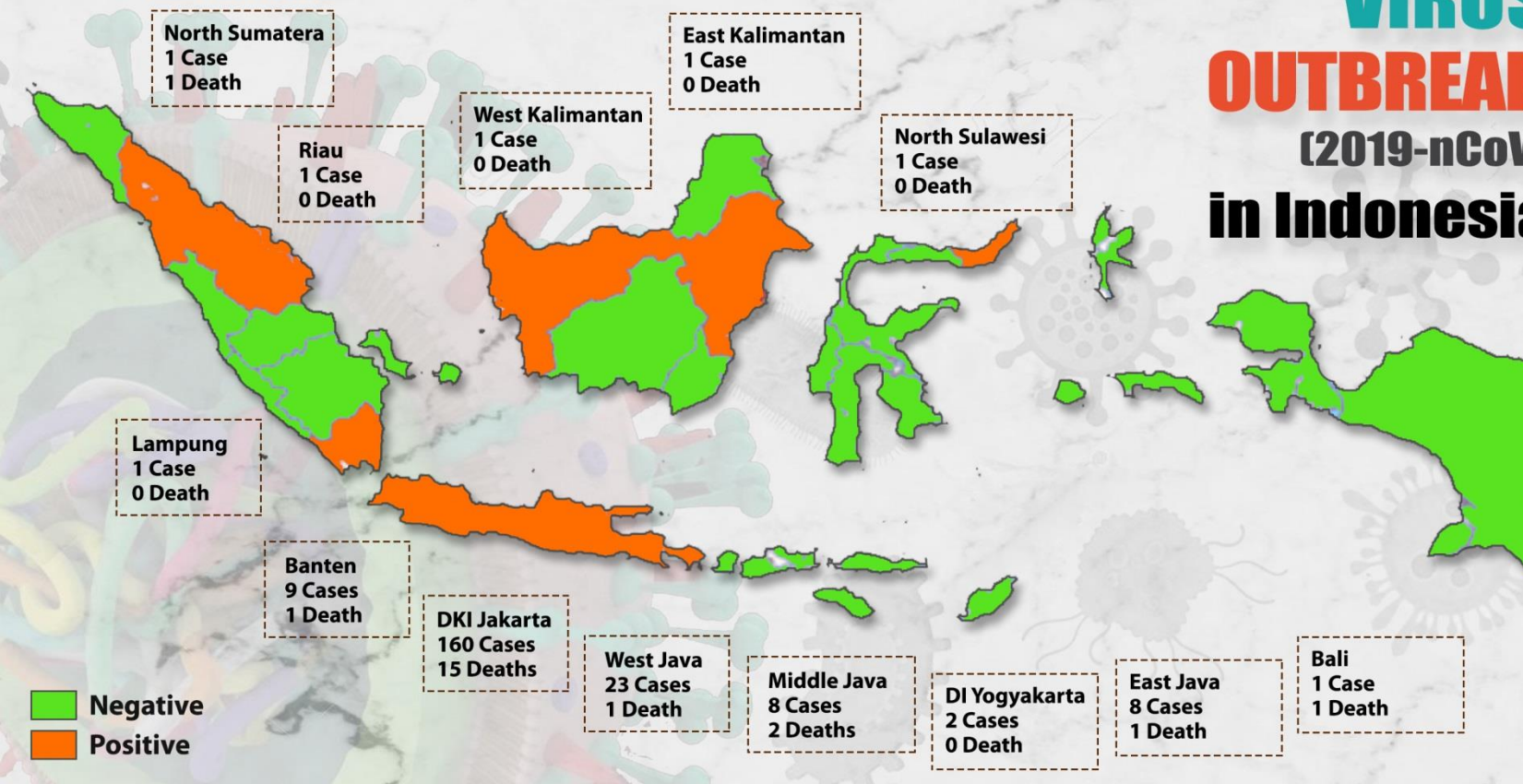

There were 245,613 cases of coronavirus spread in 160 countries (3/20). 88,437 (41.5%) of them recovered, 10,048 people died and 7,378 in critical condition.

Meanwhile in Indonesia until Thursday (19/03) there were 309 positive patients infected with coronavirus, 25 people died and 15 recovered.

The Indonesian government sets the Corona pandemic response period in Indonesia until May 29, 2020.

The government calls on people to work and carry out activities at home to prevent the spread of the more massive corona virus.

It is feared that it will cause panic buying, resulting in scarcity and rising prices of basic commodities.

Meanwhile in Indonesia, there are many daily wage earners such as online motorcycle taxis, laborers and others.

HYGIENE KIT

- The package consists of surgical mask, sanitizer and hand washing soap, to prevent Corona virus transmission

2. Sanitizer (250 ml)
3. Soap (375 ml)



MOBILE MEDICAL SERVICES

- Mobile Medical Services Health checks for underprivileged families and vulnerable ages.
- Equipped with adequate medical equipment, a Pre-Hospital Ambulance unit stand-by to provide services to people experiencing symptoms of Covid-19
- Each unit of the Pre-Hospital Ambulance is escorted by 1 doctor, 2 nurses and 4 volunteers.
