# WHAT WE DO

Jamaican reefs have endured a lot of damage and seen severe decreases in fish populations and coral coverage since the 1980s due to overfishing, hurricanes, pollution, and rising sea temperatures.

To protect the coral reef from overfishing, we employ 12 wardens to patrol the sanctuary and ensure no fishermen are fishing within the protected areas.

To restore the coral and fish populations, three of our trained coral gardeners build and plant coral nurseries in our 3 nursery sites using well-established methods in Jamaica.

To engage the local community, we focus on spreading awareness about the importance of marine ecosystems for social and economic stability in Jamaica. Our goal is to achieve 500 % more fish biomass in 5 years !
