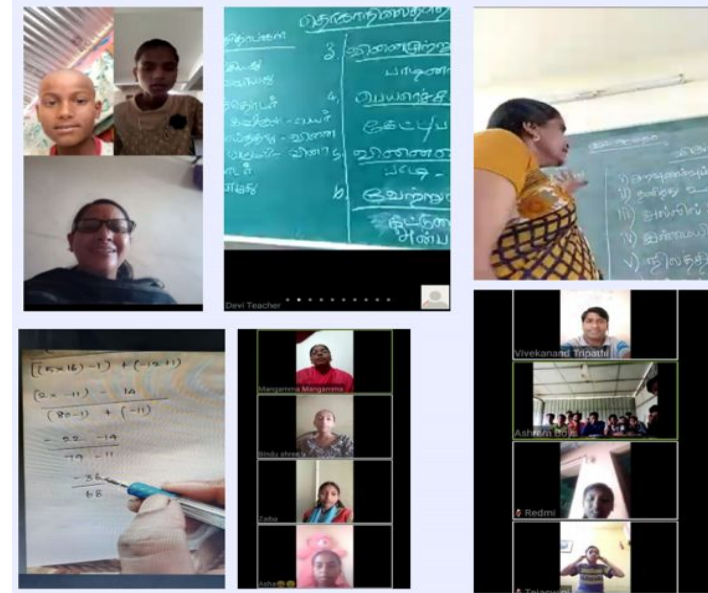
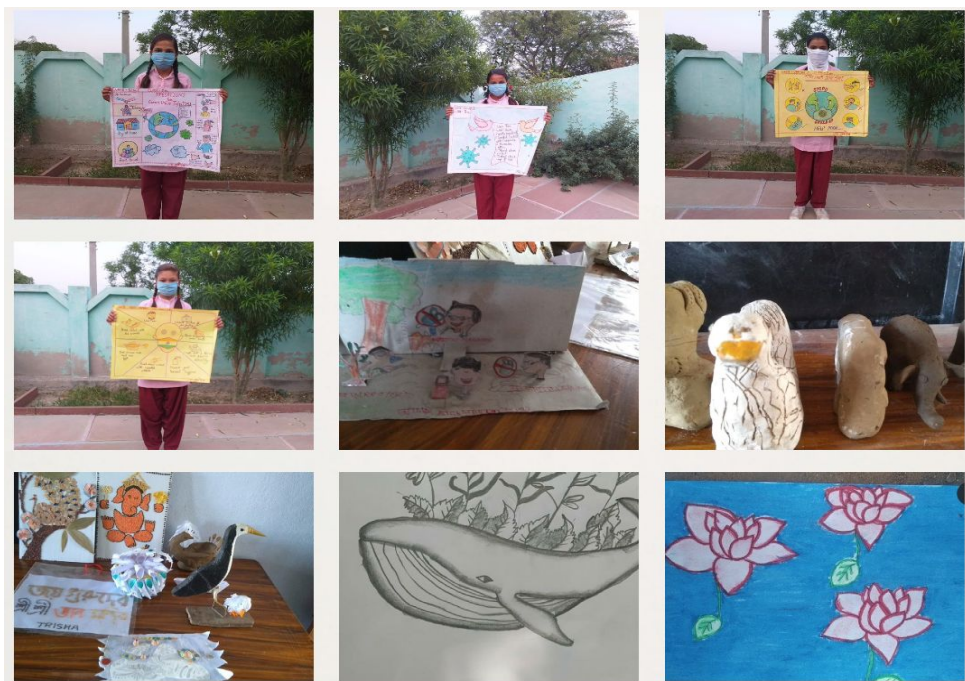


Gift a Smile Global Giving Report (1st quarter, 2021)
