- With the guidance of **caring teachers**, he now dreams of becoming a **Doctor**, aiming to heal lives like his own.



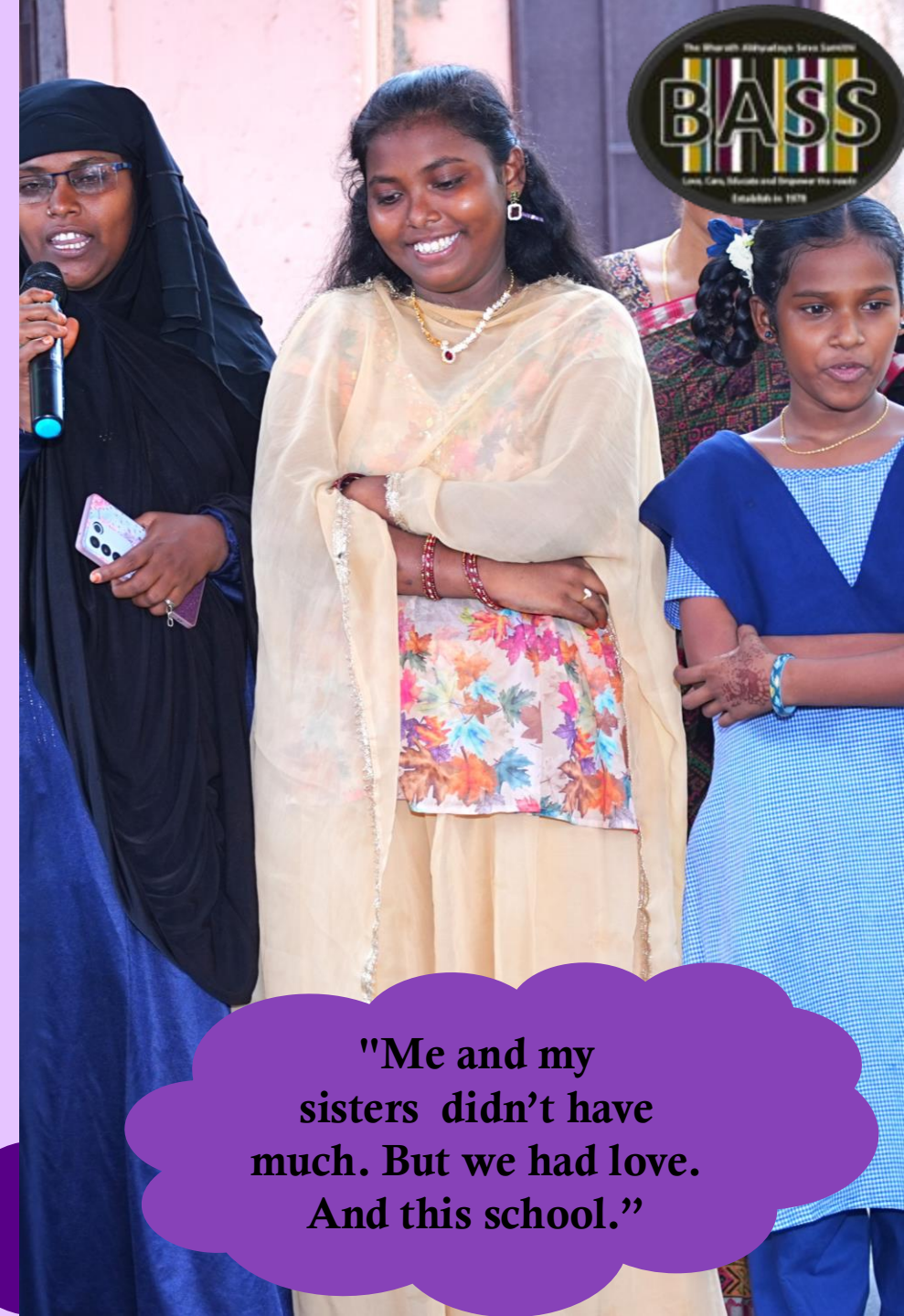

"Me and my sisters didn't have much. But we had love. And this school."

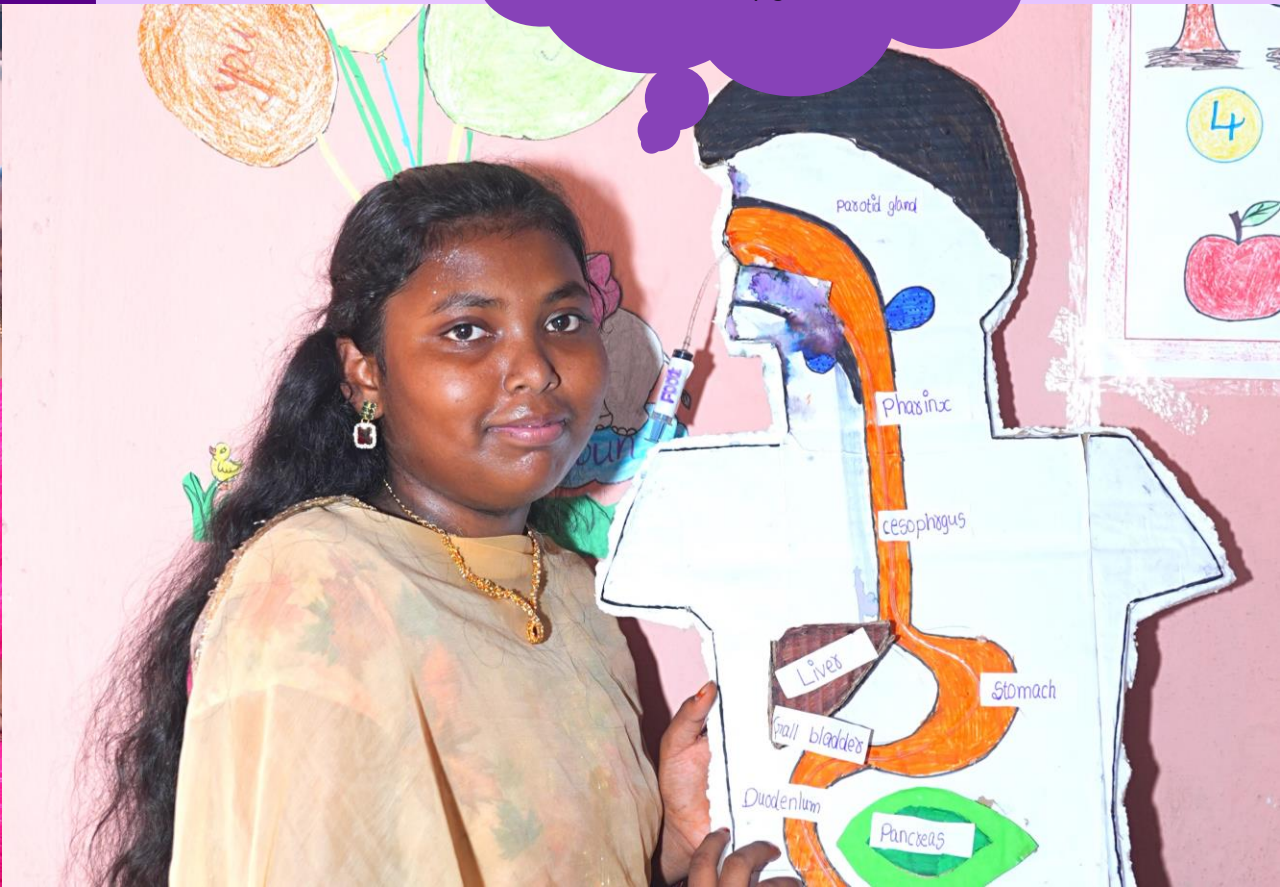
