A school year for students in Ofarim schools, which cater to students on the spectrum, can be particularly challenging and personalized for each student. Here is a summary on the subject:

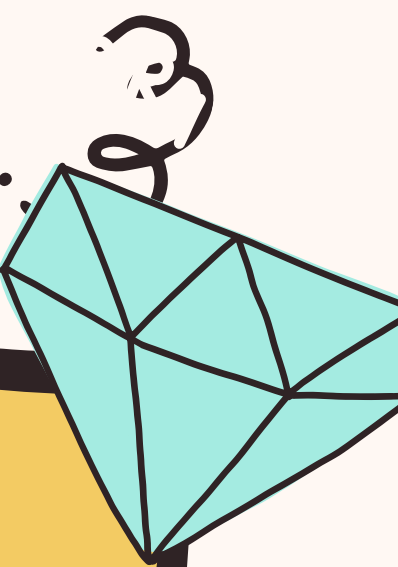
