The COVID-19 pandemic triggered a hunger crisis that is impacting an estimated 30 million Filipinos and 10 million of them are children. With the economic recession, this will only go from bad to worse.

Kusina ng Kalinga has been feeding children in schools since 2014, but the landscape of hunger is changing. There are more and more kids going hungry and most of them cannot go to school anymore. So we will go to where hunger is and serve where the children are! We aim to start with 10,000 kids in communities that are hardest hit by the effects of the prolonged quarantine such as Metro Manila, Rizal, Cavite, Laguna, Bulacan, Metro Cebu, Cagayan de Oro City, and Butuan City. From there, we hope to reach more but we can only do this with your help.

TELEPERFORMANCE PHILIPPINES

Through their COTW (Citizen of the World) program, Teleperformance has been able to keep their employees engaged and involved with communities in need. Since Typhoon Ondoy in 2009, TP has been the first to respond by rebuilding "Tanay, one of the most affected municipalities in Rizal". From 2010 to 2014, TP has been able to build a village with 100 homes, complete with a learning center and a playground. They continued to engage with this village through skills training, Nutrition projects and tree planting activities. This became the venue for volunteerism for more than 10,000 employees of TP Philippines, generating almost 50,000 volunteer hours to date.
