Akhuwat Islamic Microfinance

Akhuwat Islamic Microfinance (AIM) provides interest-free loans to the underprivileged in order to support the entrepreneurial potential of those who wish to become financially independent. Till date, AIM has provided \$760 million in interest-free loans to 3.6 million families with a repayment rate of 99.9%. The organization has a network of over 4000 employees in 826 branches spread across 400 cities in Pakistan.

Akhuwat Education Services

Akhuwat Education Services (AES) was founded in 2014 with the aim to provide quality education and prepare a diverse community of learners. AES embodies Akhuwat's vision of development and prosperity by creating a new generation of leaders. AES provides education from primary level to undergraduate level across Pakistan.



Akhuwat Health Services

Akhuwat Health Services (AHS) serves the poor through affordable, efficient, and effective healthcare. AHS provides subsidized medicines, lab tests and free consultations to families who are unable to afford basic healthcare. In 2009, AHS setup a health center in Lahore which houses a Diabetes Center, Gynecology Clinic, Psychiatric Clinic, and a General Clinic. It continues to be run by compassionate medical professionals who devote their talents and time to serve the poor.

Akhuwat Clothes Bank

Established in 2013, Akhuwat Clothes Bank (ACB) collects, sorts and cleans donated clothes and gifts in order to share them with low-income families. ACB employs and trains members of the transgender community to carry out various responsibilities and tasks. As of 2020, 2.5 million clothing items, home textiles, and furniture items have been distributed across Pakistan through this program.



Akhuwat Khwajasira Support Program

Akhuwat Khwajasira Support Program (AKSP) seeks to create a system of support for members of the Khwajasira community over the age of forty through economic and social interventions. Since 2012, hundreds of members have been registered across the country and are provided direct financial assistance, health services and psychological support.

Akhuwat Food Bank

Akhuwat Food Bank (AFB) was founded with the aim of eradicating hunger from society and ensuring adequate nutrition for all. It started by providing freshly prepared meals for those who could not afford it. It also collaborates with restaurants and catering services to collect food and distribute it amongst families which experience extreme food insecurity.



Low Income Housing Scheme

In collaboration with the Government of Pakistan, Akhuwat has launched a Low Income Housing Scheme. Shariah compliant loans up to PKR 500,000 will be provided to deserving families. Till date 7,204 families have benefited from this scheme.

COVID-19 RELIEF SERVICES

In the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic and the lockdown that ensued, millions of people across the globe lost their livelihood and struggled to make ends meet. As a result, on 20th of March 2020, Akhuwat set up Corona Imdadi Fund to provide assistance to those suffering from COVID-19 and the lockdown.

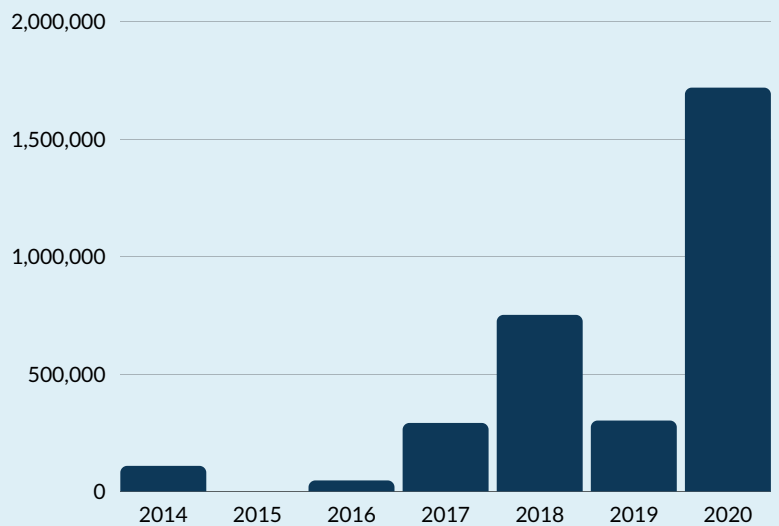
