 **1 in 2**  
**children**

lives in **extreme poverty**  
**(53.4%)**



**13,4%** of children and adolescents live in extreme poverty

**33%** structural poverty floor.  
(Chronic situation difficult to break)

**31,6%** deficit in access to basic services

**+8.5M** people live in extreme poverty

We are an NGO that has been accompanying families at social risk in Argentina for **18 years**, with programs designed so that they can grow and prosper at **every stage of their lives**.



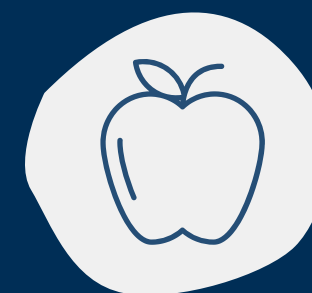

## Program

### **PURPOSE**

Protect the rights of children from 0 to 5 years of age using intensive care practices to ensure their growth, development and survival.

- Initial education
- Early stimulation
- Physical activity
- Food and nutritional care (breakfast, lunch and snack)

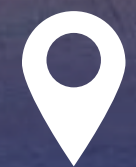


## Child Development Center at the “End of the World”
