In April 2021, we resumed the mobilization of donations for families impacted by the social isolation imposed by Covid-19, which, contrary to what we had imagined, was far from reaching an end.


We found that several families continued to be in extreme poverty due to unemployment and/or reduced wages, once again, we have the exceptional support of our Points of Light Collective to identify the most urgent demands of the community and thus mobilize partners and donations to resolve as many demands as possible.



Right away we got the support of several companies and individuals by donating items and food, and we also received fundamental support from the Global Giving Platform and Community that helped us to meet demands such as purchase of equipment, gas vouchers, Food vouchers, PPE's, Children's and geriatric diapers, milk, as well as the payment of community expenses and the Institution's operational and administrative expenses.

We started the campaign with the distribution of food baskets and food vouchers, however we found that some families were cooking on an alcohol fire or using wood as they did not have the money to buy cooking gas.

#### Other urgent demands brought by the volunteers of the Points of Light Collective were baby diapers, adult diapers, milk etc...





The amounts collected were converted into Brazilian currency - REAL and destined to the payment of essential items as well as: operational and administrative expenses of the institution employees' salaries, improvements for digital access, fees and other expenses that cannot be paid with amounts of local agreements.

Global Giving's financial support allowed financial security and avoided layoffs and cutbacks, providing excellent service to the community of Parque Imperial and to the Children and Adolescents assisted in the projects carried out by the institution.

In 5 months of the campaign, and mainly, due to the support of the Global Giving Community, we impacted 500 children, teenagers and young people served by Cepac and their families, and another 467 needy families.

It also allowed for improvements and purchases of new equipment such as: laptops and tablets for the use of children and teenagers served by the projects.

Streaming services for the 3 Institutional Reception units, impacting approximately 50 children, teenagers and 10 adults with disabilities who have suffered violence and/or do not have family members or guardians.



"I'm Gabriel's mother, he is 15 years old and has cerebral palsy: he doesn't talk, he doesn't walk. He is dependent on me for everything. I'm writing this message to thank all of you who helped me and help me with his diapers, I don't work because I have to take care of him, I have his benefit suspended, and with this pandemic, if it weren't for you, it would be more difficult. Thank you very much from my heart, may God bless each one of you for this beautiful chain of solidarity"
