DOMESTIC DISASTER TRAILERS



DA USA's Disaster Relief trailers are positioned throughout the U.S. The Trailers provide disaster relief aid more effectively. Each of the 11 U.S. Rotary zones will have a minimum of one trailer. Each Rotary zone will support one another as needed. A team of trained disaster response volunteers will accompany the trailer. The trailer will also serve as a mobile base of operations. Each zone trailer will contain items tailored to that zone depending on the disasters that normally occur in that zone.



According to the latest UN figures there are currently 15 million people around the world who are homeless because of man-made and natural disasters.

Disaster Aid USA is a Rotary Club project of the Rotary Club of Prince George's County, Maryland partnered and supported by Rotarians, Rotary Clubs, non-Rotarians, businesses, community and church groups throughout the 11 U. S. Rotary Zones.



Our Domestic Program has trained response team members throughout the US. When a disaster occurs, we immediately contact local authorities and VOAD (Volunteer Organizations Assisting in Disasters) and report our team and its capabilities depending on the team members going. We also immediately call the local Rotary District and clubs to do the same. **DAUSA Response Teams have either** received FEMA Training, Salvation Army Training, Red Cross Training, or our own DAUSA Training. Just some of the qualifications are emergency management, POD (point of distribution) management, mental health and stress management professionals, EMT and paramedics, chainsaw and debris removal, rescue diver, fire and rescue personnel, water filtration teams, to name a few.

Most importantly both domestically or internationally DA USA provide highly skilled and resourceful Response teams on the ground who understand how domestic and international aid business works as well as the personal attributes to work closely with those affected by the disaster.



We work closely with the communities affected as well as all of the onground agencies to bring this all together



To achieve this Disaster Aid USA has several skills available; Provide shelter, Mass feeding management, water purification (family and large-scale operations), Rescue, firefighting, family and youth counseling
