


Children's average letter name and sound score before the programme begins: 6

and sounds after TWO years of schooling




2020 results

The latest monitoring report in the 5 most challenging schools shows:

Average Std1 Letter Name
and Sound attainment: **76.4**

Average Std2 Letter Name
and Sound attainment: **104.4**


Average Std3 Letter Name
and Sound attainment: **146.8**



Observation: Assessment of the remaining schools was interrupted by COVID-19 lockdown measures in Malawi.



1st grade learners from the current academic year (2019–20) were showing faster, more secure progress until COVID–19 shut schools down in March 2020.
