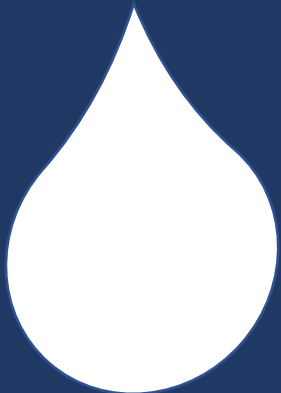

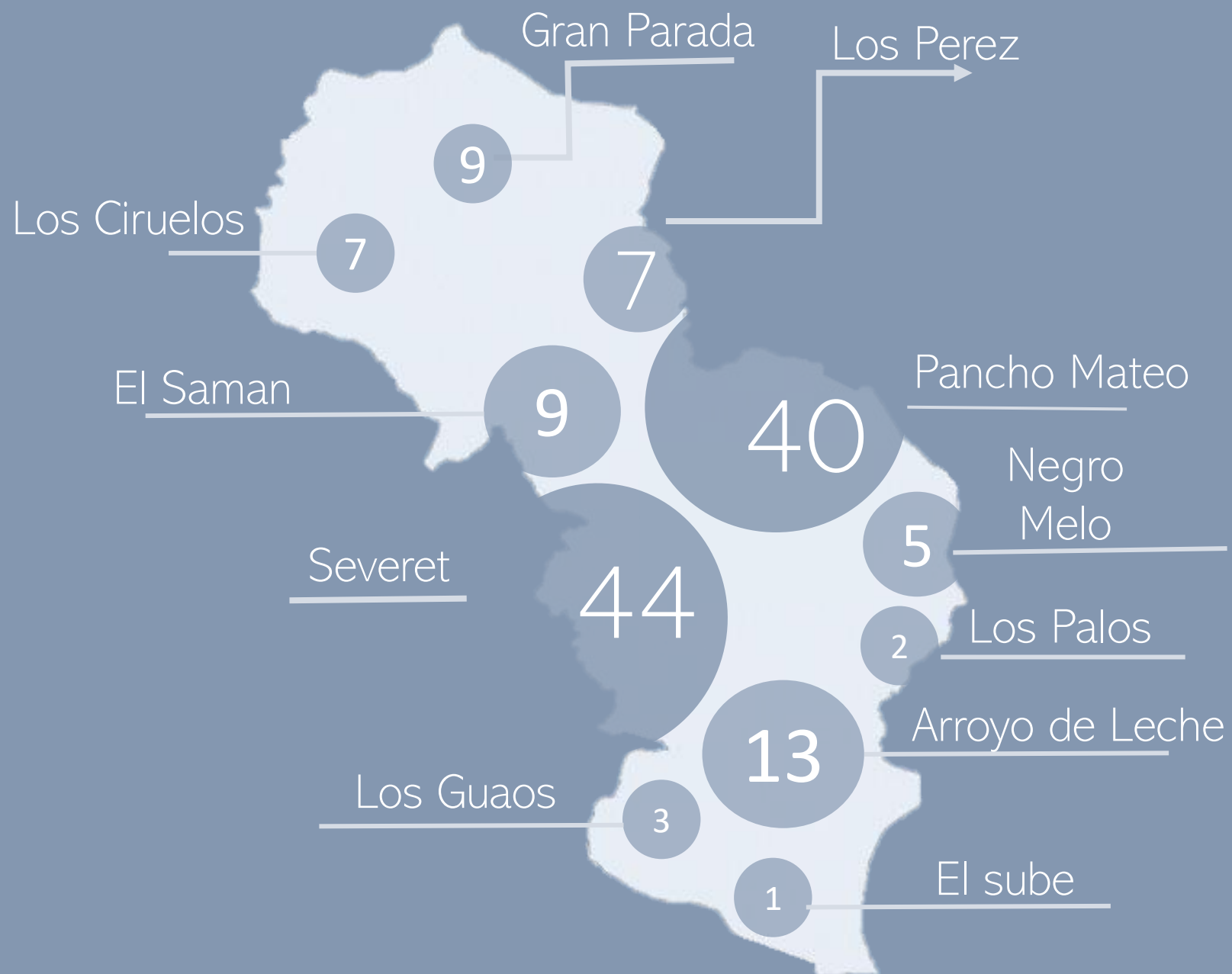

REFERRAL CARE

Through our Referral Program, we work collaboratively with specialist doctors or specialized institutions in specific health areas to offer complementary care to patients, beyond the primary care services we offer in the Chronic Care Program. During clinics or the monthly visits that the family doctor makes to patients, we can assess if the patient needs resources outside the portfolio of services of the CCP Program, so we serve as a link between them and specialists such as dentists, psychologists, oncologists, pulmonologists, and nephrologists.
