At Fundación PAS we join the **#YoSoyFreedom** campaign to give voice to children and teenagers who are sexually exploited in Mexico.



The president of the civil association, Fernando Landeros, introduced the Spokespeople for Freedom.



During the event, agreements were signed with Aeromexico, Consejo Ciudadano para la Seguridad y Justicia CDMX and Fundación PAS to together create synergy and provide the tools to prevent child sexual exploitation.


"YOUTH SAFETY, WELL BEING AND CSAM: AN OVERVIEW OF MÉXICO"
