ESSENTIAL LIFE TRAINING SKILLS FOR YOUTH

Bright Side Project's unique Brighter Futures Initiative empowers youth via paid apprenticeship and educational support for a brighter future. This has been in mind for us for the past few years to be able to provide our kids with guidance on the next step in the journey of life. This organically came to be after we had been in operation for almost a decade and we knew that our kids, now growing into young adults, needed support in other parts of their lives.

We had provided mentoring and assisted with health check ups, prescription eyewear exams, and accompanying children to job interview and college interviews before we launched the program in 2019.

In 2020 we kicked off our essential life skill training and had mentorships, tutoring in mathematics, mock interviews, and provided youth with paid volunteer opportunities at various industries to enhance their network and skills.



and even had one of our youths from 2013 Toayuan Muhsiang Children's Home come in the Bright Side Projects headquarters as a paid summer apprentice.



In the two month stint, we had assigned a series of tasks and goals to achieve. He learned how to build a website, set a foundation for basic budget management, hone his writing skills for his planned future in social services, and create presentations in newly decked out work attire that increased his confidence. He also joined in our workshops to assist younger kids who were once his age when he first met us!

Each work day started off with going over his daily tasks and assigning him a mentor to oversee and guide him. Learning was not just a one way street as we also learned so much from him and so proud to have him head out to volunteer for human rights and also accomplish a dream - build a website for the children's home!
