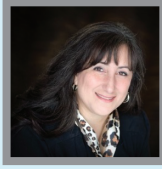

PATRICIA WILLIAMS, MS, FACHE



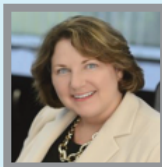
- President and Founder of Global Health Charities and Global Health Services Network as well as one of the founders of the first private school of nursing in Myanmar.

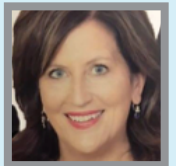
