

Among our families 18% now earn more than the minimum wage

Among our families, violence against women has dramatically decreased

Our priorities and wishes...

Next two years

Short-Term

- Launch the Fundraising program <u>"Phase 1"</u> to assure the Foundation's financial sustainability.
- Hire professionals to improve the quality and frequency of every activity.
- Implement language courses during weekdays (English and Portuguese).
- Adequate our facilities to fulfill government requirements.
- Implement Project <u>"Always with You"</u> to support teenagers' further development.
- Vocational training for teenagers and young adults.

Next two to five years


Mid-Term

- Professional Workshop for Parents
- Increase our capacity to host up to 200 Children.
- Offer psychological support to children with emotional and mental disorders.
- Implement a self-sustainable business to cover all the Foundation's costs.
- Start Fundraising program <u>"Phase 2"</u> with an international office.
- Extend monthly grocery support to more vulnerable families.
- Find partners to support the children's college fees.


Next 5 to 10 years
