As part of the global Aflatoun network, we also shared the NATCCO's experience in the ChildFund National Partners' Conference on July 11, 2018 at Luxe Hotel, Cagayan de Oro City. The activity presented opportunities for collaboration among ChildFund partner organizations in areas of Life Skills and Entrepreneurship.

| AUGUST 18-21 CEBU PHILIPPINES



The International Cooperative Alliance-Asia and Pacific (ICA-AP) and the ICA-EU Partnership on Co-operatives in Development: People Centered Businesses in Action (#coops4dev) and its members in the Philippines, Namely Aurora Integrated Multi-purpose Cooperative, Cooperative Development Authority (CDA), Federation of Peoples' Sustainable Development Cooperative (FPSDC), National Confederation of Cooperatives (NATCCO), MASS-SPECC Cooperative Development Center, Philippine Cooperative Center (PCC), United of Legitimate Service Contracting Cooperative, and VICTO National Cooperative Federation and Development Center, successfully concluded the second edition of the Asia Pacific Cooperative Youth Summit 2018! From the first international gathering of Youth in Indonesia, we brought the Asia Pacific Co-operative Youth Summit 2.0 to the Queen City of the South -Cebu, Philippines!

The Philippines was this year's host country, working with the theme: 'Creative Skills, Cooperative Entrepreneurship and Sustainable Development' last August 17-21, 2018. The 4-day Summit has evolved into a combination of inspiring talks delivered by Youth Leaders from the Asia Pacific and the Global Co-op exchanging movement, of ideas, commitment-building between 138 Youth delegates from 17 countries in Asia-Pacific.

The Summit served as a good opportunity to discuss Cooperative enterprise ideas that aim to fulfill youth-centric targets. A major attraction of the first Summit was the inclusion of 'Coop Pitch'. It was conceived to be a contest where groups of young Cooperators present Coop business ideas that will be owned and managed by young persons, and serve as ecommerce for Co-ops. Summit participants tackled issues on youth development with tangible solutions based on their personal experiences and learning.



















Ng Jun Long, Youth delegate from Ngee Ann Polytechnic Consumer Cooperative Society Limited in Singapore won 1st place for this Youth Summit's Coop Pitch. He proposed Skyla Energy Cooperative, a cooperative that will be founded by the students of Ngee Ann Polytechnic with products that will make use of renewable energy, such as solar panels.

Outdoor activities and team-building exercises were also a major part of this year's Summit. Through the generous leadership of Lamac Multi-Purpose Cooperative and the overwhelming support of Cebu Provincial Government and the whole Municipality of Pinamungajan, the participants experienced a unique cultural immersion that looked at Philippine agriculture from a different, yet highly dynamic angle. Young leaders from different countries enjoyed getting their hands dirty and learning about the richness of agriculture in Cebu, they were exposed to rice planting, silage and vermi culture-making, cacao grafting, and fermented plant juice making, even to the very unforgettable lunch with the community!

This Summit proved to be a great avenue for the Youth to be involved and speak out for the sustainable future of the cooperative movement and definitely showed the Asia-Pacific delegates that it really is more fun in the Philippines!
