

For the past 26 years, ORT SA CAPE has been operating at the forefront of education in the Western Cape.



Through our training programmes, we address critical educational challenges including South Africa's poor literacy rate as well as focus on educating, training, supporting and empowering teachers in disadvantaged communities. Ultimately, better trained teachers result in better educated children. Our vision is a future where all teachers receive quality training and all children have access to quality education. During 2019, ORT SA CAPE trained over 1700 teachers indirectly reaching approximately 51 000 learners.

ORT SA CAPE is currently focusing on four core areas:

TEACHER TRAINING:

Due to the challenges in our education system, we focus our training on Early Childhood Development (ECD) and foundational learning skills in young children. Courses include Literacy development, Perceptual Skills development, and Learning through Play. We also offer pre-service training for unemployed youth to study towards a qualification in ECD.

PURPOSEFUL PLAY:

Foundation, ORT SA CAPE
distributes LEGO resources and
offers training on the use of these
resources to schools and ECD
centres in disadvantaged
communities across the
Western Cape.



ECD INTERNSHIP:

This initiative addresses
South Africa's high unemployment
rate by recruiting, training, and
placing young men and women in
schools as teaching assistants for
one year.

This allows for interns to develop a love for education and potentially continue in this field in the future.

EDUTECH HUB:

Our Edutech hub focuses on training educators to demystify coding, technology and robotics in order to incorporate these technologies in their classroom and curriculum.

We are in the process of developing an ORT online platform which will allow for better online and blended learning opportunities.

Through the generosity of donors, we have initiated a feeding programme for families in disadvantaged communities in which ORT SA CAPE works. By drawing on our network, we are assisting the most needy – including child-headed families, grandparent-headed families and those with little or no income.
