The Nature Village project located in Sabana Yegua Viejo, Azua, includes the co-creation of the first sustainable community in the Caribbean region that will operate entirely with solar energy and already is giving people in situations of poverty and vulnerability the opportunity to close their development gaps jointly bringing access to clean energy, water and sanitation, housing improvement, education, technology and sustainable entrepreneurship with the implementation of a fish farm system led by women and young people, a telemetering system with information available in an open data platform and eco-friendly housing construction. This project benefits 50 families.

We have already raised funds to start building 39 homes to benefit almost 200 people.
