SOCIAL AND LABOR REINSERTION OF 120 WOMEN LEADERS VICTIMS OF THE ARMED CONFLICT IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CALIMA- DARIEN COLOMBIA

Project summary

- Who are you helping?: 120 Women victims of the conflict armed
- What are you doing?: psychosocial support, building a Life Project, and creating a self-sustaining business.
- How do you do it?: tailor-made support through Sustainable Solidarity Economic Systems
- Where are you doing it?: Municipality of Calima - Darien Colombia.

ABSTRACT

This project helps to strengthen and restore dignity to a group of 120 women leaders who are victims of the armed conflict, who as displaced have precarious living conditions, the incomes will be supported with the creation of a sustainable community business through transformation of discarded tires into handicrafts and furniture for domestic use. Donation options

- \$ 10 supports a displaced woman to get entrepreneurial training.
- \$ 25 supports a woman entrepreneur to train her in accounting and finance
- \$ 50 buys a tire reuse tool
- \$ 60 help with the psychosocial support of a woman victim of the armed conflict in Colombia
- \$ 75 provides equipment to transform tires into home furniture
- \$ 100 will free a woman from bounded labor

What is the problem or challenge?

The armed conflict in Colombia has directly affected 8,376,463 people, 120 displaced women leaders from different areas of the country took refuge in Calima Darién, Valle del Cauca, who have suffered different types of harassment, such as rape, the murder of their husbands and families, leaving psychosocial trauma in their families and themselves, increasing intrafamily violence, besides with this is the fact that they have lost their jobs and the material assets they owned.

The LA ALIANZA Corporation will support the social and labor reintegration of these leaders through psychosocial accompaniment to each of the 120 family nucleus and the formation of a community business through the reuse of tires for crafts and home furnishings, generating economic income and the improvement of the environment where they live.

How will this solve the problem?

The project is designed to contribute two aspects that are affecting this group of displaced women, the emotional and economic situation.

In the emotional aspect, each one of the 120 women and their families will be accompanied with psychosocial therapies addressing issues such as mental health, resilience, socio-economic consolidation, and stabilization; Through tailor-made training, the project of family and collective life will be built, addressing the different dimensions of human well-being.

The solution to the labor and economic problem will be made through the implementation of Sustainable Economic Systems building a collective company from the reuse of tires to manufacture crafts and home furniture, organizational, administrative, and financial skills are generated so that the company is profitable, sustainable and will produce income by improving the quality of life.

Long-term potential impact

The project helps to generate new life possibilities for 120 women and their families in a new geographical context, we began with psychosocial support that allows reducing the classic tensions and depressions of displacement and that generate intra-family violence, which is accompanied by the construction of the life project which is done from the different dimensions of well-being.

A process of labor reintegration is generated through a community company from the Solidarity Economy approach that allows them to be self-sustainable and self-managed and is supported by caring for the environment by recycling and reusing tires in crafts and home furnishings.
