Since our last update, The Virgin Islands Children's Museum has hosted engaging arts activities as part of our Toddler Tuesday program, as well as Storytime and Crafts sessions to celebrate Grade-Level Reading Week. In collaboration with several organizations on St. Thomas, we organized a special event focused on promoting early childhood literacy and fostering a love for reading and getting creative with stories. This event was made possible through the Campaign for Grade-Level Reading (CGLR), a collaborative effort aimed at ensuring the academic success of children from low-income families.
