

Background

The Institute for Social Sciences and Humanities – also known as Iran Academia – was established in 2012 as a qualified online university in response to widespread and systematic violations of **academic freedom**, including lack of **university autonomy**, in Iran and as an attempt to empower the Persian speaking community through quality and uncensored education.



In 2018, in order to better bridge the gap between the academic community and civil society, Iran Academia launched a new platform **AcademiX**. The platform seeks to provide unlimited access to unrestricted free resources in Persian by leveraging the potential of the recently emerged Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) phenomenon.

After much effort, AcademiX has since launched three outstanding MOOCs, on the Economy, Human Rights and on Children's Rights which have attracted over 3,000 participants so far.

2021 Transitional Justice


The MOOC will be the first open online course in Persian on transitional justice and will address a critical educational gap in countries with histories of mass atrocities, such as Iran, where people are denied access to education on issues related to accountability and truth-seeking. Iran academia has already advanced on the design and the development of the course, and also identified the academic scholars and practitioners who will be invited to deliver video lectures. These lectures along with other course materials will be made available through Iran Academia's existing infrastructure which has proved successful in delivering high quality online education to large audiences.
