

Introduction





The concert experience will comprise 1 and half hours non-stop music dance and cultural sharing, with some Ugandan guest artists including cultural dance troupes.



The "Night Before" Event


The Night before concert will be there for a few members. The Bbanda Hills Camp site is offering space to have this possible.


