Endemic Seeds Bank to empower women and girls

Despite the fact that the pandemic has been a huge impact for every one. At Na Bolom we have manage to keep working. We have experienced difficulties to work with kids as the schools in this area are still closed, and the communities don't want to get vaccinated, now we stablished an agreement with local highschools, COBACH, in order to continue to build nurseries and gather seeds.



The communities have already stablished a nursery even with the schools closed

The parents have organized and are including children in the process.

We have visited the region of Montes Azules in the lacandon forests to identify the different kinds of trees and possible seeds. We have had meetings with the principals of 5 highschools in the area to determine how to continue the work.

Today, the first seeds bank opened is at Na Bolom.

We are training people interested to Reach out active learning.



We have also renewed the nursery in Zinacantan, in Yo'onik and have started the bank seeds with the help of women and the kids that participate in their activities.



The season to gather starts at the beginning of October, so we are setting some campaigns in different areas to increase the seeds in Na Bolom's bank, and start the collection in the other nurseries.
