



















# Members area **Working groups**

# The Taskforce on Inequality-related Financial Disclosures (TIFD)

TIFD is led by an Interim Secretariat that includes Red Argentina de Cooperación Internacional (RACI), the Predistribution Initiative (PDI), Rights CoLab, the Center for Southern Inequality Studies (SCIS) and the United Nations Development Program(**UNDP**).

Recently, we have been working with the Task Force on Social Financial Disclosures (TSFD) as B4IG and the **OECD** to consolidate into a single initiative.





# Civil Society Networking

We reflected on the role of Argentine Civil Society in the challenges posed by the green and digital transitions, shared experiences between organisations that have implemented projects co-funded by the EU, and identified innovative models.

We are working on the Better Rules for Social Organisations campaign, so that organisations can have a proper tax and labour framework, based on simple rules and free procedures.



















































### **I4C Global Secretary**

Hub Lac (Latin America and the Caribbean) has been selected as the Global Secretariat for Innovation for Change (I4C). In this momentous role, Argentina, represented by RACI, and Ecuador, represented by FARO, will play a crucial role in leading the executive team of the global secretariat.

Assigned responsibilities include coordination of global activities of the seven hubs and focus on communication strategies to strengthen collaboration and disseminate meaningful initiatives.







### National Coordinators Good Deeds Day Argentina

### RACI was selected to be national coordinator of the Good Deeds day.

We were in Costa Rica representing RACI, this new alliance seeks to create positive changes in communities by spreading the Good Deeds Day (GDD) throughout the world. The global initiative promotes volunteer work, good deeds, mobilization and empowerment of participants by facilitating volunteer activities on Good Deeds Day and throughout the year.







# United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC)

We obtained Civil Society Organisation (CSO) status in consultative status with ECOSOC.

### This new status allows us to:

- Participate actively in ECOSOC and its subsidiary bodies.
- Appoint official representatives to UN Headquarters in New York and the UN Offices in Geneva and Vienna.
- Register and participate in UN meetings, events, conferences and activities.
- Submit written statements relevant to the work of the Council on matters in which we have particular expertise.
- In addition, as an organisation in general and special consultative status, we have the opportunity to designate authorised representatives to participate as observers in public sessions of ECOSOC and its subsidiary bodies, the Human Rights Council and, under certain conditions, the General Assembly and other intergovernmental bodies of the United Nations.





## International Association for Volunteer **Effort (IAVE)**

### **RACI** was selected to be a member of the Committee

Founded in 1970, IAVE is the International Association for Volunteer Effort. It exists to promote, strengthen and celebrate volunteering in its myriad forms throughout the world. It is a global network of NGOs, corporations, national volunteer centres and grassroots volunteer leaders with members in 70 countries in every region of the world.






