

PROJECT REPORT CHILDREN'S UJI PROGRAM (CUP)

This is a progress report submitted for the Children's Uji Program (CUP) with regards to Preventing Maternal & Child Malnutrition in Kenya implemented by Project Afya in Githurai. The schools in this locality have been affected by childhood malnutrition due to the high rate of poverty in the community. If this problem is not addressed in time, the effects are usually irreversible.

The CUP was rolled out in June 2021, and so far 165 children in the Early Childhood Development Education (ECDE) at Kimbo Githurai Primary School have benefitted. We provide nutritious breakfast porridge to the children twice a week, and already there has been an increase in school enrollment from 136-165 children.Our goal is to provide porridge five days a week.



The program runs with the help of community volunteers who help in preparing and making sure that the porridge cools to the right temperatures before serving. We would like to take this opportunity to thank our staff and volunteers for their important contribution.
