

KAP MARGINALISED/UNREACHED YOUTHS PROJECT ACTIVITIES FROM THE 1st APRIL 2021 THROUGH THE 28th JULY 2021								
SUMMARY								
THE PROJECT CORE CYCLE OF UNREACHED YOUTHS PROJECTS typically consists of								
community mobilisation visits, introductory sessions with area leaders (Chiefs, Assistant Chiefs, Church- and other Community Leaders, followed by participants selection, core- and continuous education workshops, and follow-up activities.								
The follow-up activities consist of Micro-Meetings (MMs: counselling sessions in small groups), Micro-Teachings (MTs: during which participants learn how to 'pass on their message' to and/or hold 'helping talks' with others), and household education visits by participants in their neighbourhoods.								
Besides community educative purposes the latter has shown to also help participants build their self-esteem and appreciation by the community. Visits are KAP-guided.								
There also are One-on-One Counselling Sessions, Guided Education Sessions (community education in groups), whilst the cycle is completed by assessment and graduation.								
For those interested (usually the majority) an ADVANCED COURSE of 1 year continuous education and activities is offered, and repeated for additional year(s) according to need.								
<p>DURING THE PERIOD 1st APRIL 2021 - 28th JULY 2021 the following Unreached Youths activities took place:</p> <p>There were 2 CORE WORKSHOPS (of 6 non-residential days each) in the focus areas of Sabata (with 34 participants) and Shimo la Tewa (with 62 participants)</p> <p>Due to COVID-19 the Shimo la Tewa group was split into two.</p> <p>The core workshops were followed by 3 REFRESHER/ CONTINUOUS EDUCATION WORKSHOPS in both areas, with 25/34 (= 74% in Sabata) and 41/62 (= 66% in Shimo) participants.</p> <p>After the core workshops a series of follow-up activities was started, namely: MICRO-MEETINGS (MMs) and MICRO-TEACHINGS (MTs)</p> <p>There was a total of 35 MM/MTs sessions (Sabati: 22 and Shimo: 13), attended by 80/96 participants (Sabata: 30/34 and Shimo 50/62).</p> <p>Absenteeism during workshops and MMs/MTs was mainly due to sickness, family or work pressures.</p> <p>In addition a start was made with HOUSEHOLD EDUCATION VISITS in the Sabata area with 16/34 participants in training. They visited 46 households, repeatedly providing community education and helping talks for 56 beneficiaries (i.e. 1.22 persons per household).</p> <p>The Shimo group is yet to embark on MTs and Household Visits, due to the many personal and group issues that needed to be addressed first.</p>
