THE CLUB 10 INITIATIVE: Clean Water and Sanitation for All






Hand washing is a community's first defense against the virus, but a shocking number of underserved communities do not have piped water and soap for hand washing. Nearly 1 in 3 Kenyans lack access to clean water, and are without safe and dignified toilets. CLUB 10 initiative seeks to create a groundswell of support for equitable and sustainable safe water access, improved sanitation and hygiene and strengthened ability of underprivileged communities to develop and maintain sustainable water and sanitation systems.









CLUB 10 is also a nod to the 10 years we are from 2030, when the United Nations has challenged our sector to finally end the world water crisis and ensure everyone has reliable access to water and a toilet. CLUB 10 is our way of saying there's a way for everyone to contribute. 


While \$10 per month may not seem much, over a year's time, this grows to \$120 and provides at least one person with reliable water access for an entire year.
