#### **BODY SAFETY EDUCATION**

Body safety education is about providing children with information and tools they need to help keep them safe from CSA (Child sexual abuse). We teach body safety education (Child Sexual Abuse Prevention) across schools in rural communities for children ages 3-10 in other to reduce the occurrence of sexual abuse in children and improve children's abilities to recognize inappropriate physical contact and also to empower children to disclose the abuse to non-offending, trusted adults.
