The essential food items and Health Kits will be great support for poor and marginalized people, particularly children and young women of the targeted districts. These people are largely neglected and have affected by the COVID-19 related treatment, care and food insufficiency. This campaign can help provide essential food; and basic COVID safety, health and hygiene materials along with sanitary products like face masks, hand washing soap and sanitizers.

What is the problem?
