





Only 38% of the cities in the North of the county have access to broadband internet, the lowest index in Brazil:

- 70% South
- 56% Northeast
- 65% Southeast 58% Midwest

"Lack of Internet access is one of the main reasons for not doing activities at home"



The difficulty of accessing the internet intensifies inequalities in education. In 2020, in-person classes in public schools have been suspended and return predictions still uncertain.

THE PROJECT




The main objective of this project is to expand internet access in the Amazon, as a way to expand access to reading and, consequently, its positive impact on education and the empowerment of local rural communities.
