**3,101**

The number of physical rehab, medical consults, and psychosocial support services provided to children at our new Fallujah clinic.



**36,000+**

The number of nutritious meals served to children on the Hope Buses in 2024. Daily meals are provided to all registered children.



**539+**

At our centers in Mosul, more than 500 girls are registered, and attend to receive psychosocial or education support.



**100%**

All children on our Hope Buses received new school supplies, and winter and summer clothes and shoes in 2024.



**633**

Our lawyers handled 633 legal cases in 2024, including human trafficking, legal documents, and representation in courts.



**50+**

More than 50 children are regularly using our minibus service, providing school transportation for Hope Bus graduates.



**152 + 108**

152 children attended the Hope Bus programs in 2024, and 108 children received psychosocial support.



**3 + 1**

ICF now operates in three cities in Iraq (Baghdad, Mosul, Fallujah), with a planned expansion into Basra in 2025.

We celebrated 12 years of our "In Their Shoes" 5K, with a special walk/run in Washington D.C.

We are pleased to report that 2024 was ICF's biggest year ever for program spending, with an increase of 11.44% over 2023.

## TOP MATTERS IN 2024

Human trafficking remains a major problem, with an increase in all types of trafficking recorded in 2024.

Our disability clinic in Fallujah expanded to include a mobile medical clinic, with plans to open a new clinic in Basra in 2025.

Our newest center for girls in Mosul completed their first full year of operations, providing crucial services.

A major currency devaluation resulted in ICF costs increasing by 20% for months, just to maintain programs.
